

1.0 MD Learning Communities

What is a Learning Community?

As a student, you will join a 'learning community' during your first year. Each 'learning community' is geographically based bringing together students, academics, clinical teachers and professional staff. Learning communities provide a clinical home where students are engaged in learning from each other and are supported to flourish as they develop as a medical professional across the MD program.

When will I attend my Learning Community?

Students will be based at the MD Learning Hub at St Lucia for Year 1 but will also undertake some learning experiences within their allocated Learning Community.

Throughout their studies, students will have the opportunity to experience other Learning Communities.

Where are the Learning Communities?

Learning Community	Hospitals
Central	Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital, Greenslopes Private Hospital and community providers
North	The Prince Charles Hospital, Caboolture Hospital, Redcliffe Hospital and community providers
South	The Princess Alexandra Hospital, Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee Hospital and community providers
West	Mater Hospital, Ipswich Hospital and community providers



1.1 Learning Communities – preferencing

What you can preference depends on the type of student you are:

UQ-Ochsner Medical Student

- Central
- South



Central Queensland and Wide Bay Regional Medical Pathway (RMP) Students are already allocated!

Central QLD students = Central

Wide Bay students = South

2.1 Logging into the Placement System


To preference for your Year 1 Learning Community, you will need to access the Placement System, InPlace.



How to preference for your Learning Community in the Placements System





3.1 Preferencing MD Learning Communities

In the *Placements* system, Learning Communities will not be shown directly, but will be represented by the Home Hospital that is associated with each Learning Community.

In order to complete Learning Community preferencing, you will need to preference based on the corresponding Home Hospital shown below.

Learning Community	Home Hospital you should select within the preferencing system
Central	Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital
North	The Prince Charles Hospital
South	The Princess Alexandra Hospital
West	Mater Hospital




3.2 Preferencing – where to find it




Note:

Agency preferences = Learning Community Preferences






3.3 Preferencing – Selecting preferences



Once you've clicked the Agency Preferences link this screen will appear.

- 1. Select **all** the Home Hospitals displayed by clicking the blue square arrays
- 2. Click the next button to proceed to the next screen







3.3 Preferencing – Selecting preferences

Back Select the order of preference



- 1. Arrange the Home hospitals in your chosen preferencing order
- 2. Once happy with the order, click the 'submit preferences' button



Note: You can drag or use the arrows to move the order around



Note: You can come back and change your preference order at any time until preferencing closes. If you come back to modify your preferences it is important to note that they will be displayed in alphabetical order not the order you preferenced in.

What is my Allocation?

This represents the Learning Community you will be allocated to for the duration of your studies.

Where can I see my allocation?

Your allocation will be visible in the Placements system, in the confirmed pane
