

# eConsultant: Improving GP access to specialist care for patients

## 65 GPs are now signed up for eConsultant across 8 WQPHN and 6 BSPHN practices.

 Two GPs who recently came on board have been active in accessing the program to gain specialist input for their patients (ranging in age from 20 to 86 years).

## **Case Example**

Day 1Mrs Brown is 87, living in a high care nursing home and is a new patient to the GP. She has<br/>multiple comorbidities including T2DM (33 years), OP (on ca/vit d/bisphosphonate), IHD<br/>(stable), Barrett's oesophagus & GORD, Parkinson's disease, cognitive impairment, CKD<br/>3b, Sjogren's, diverticular disease, HTN, MNG on CBZ. Frequent falls.

#### GP has 1 RFA question:

- 1. CBZ out of stock can we cease or consider some other Rx options?
- Physician responds that as the Tfts show a suppressed TSH, & fT4 in the upper range of normal, MNG is still overactive. Best option for this lady would be to continue on antithyroid medication if CBZ unavailable then swap to PTU (propylthiouracil) 50mg/day as an equivalent dose. Would not consider RAI in this setting.
   In addition the physician notes that Josie is on 3 antihypertensives & Lasix. Given her PD age, likely general frailty & falls risk, wonders if these can be down titrated? Aiming for a systolic BP of 150-160 in this age group with her set of comorbidities.
- Day 4 GP switched Josie to PFU 50mg daily. Weaning anti-hypertensives due to polypharmacy & multiple falls
