The ACE endocarditis Symposium in Brisbane, on Saturday October 12th, will be a hybrid meeting, bringing together many disciplines to discuss evolving aspects of endocarditis.

This is the first symposium for ACE- Australasian Collaboration in endocarditis (and the first endocarditis symposium in Australia in 5 years).

We expect this symposium to attract infectious diseases physicians, microbiologists, cardiologists, cardio-thoracic-surgeons, general physicians, stroke physicians, intensive care physicians, imaging specialists, pharmacists, researchers and anyone with an interest in endocarditis.

Being a hybrid conference, we expect at least 50 consultants to attend in person, and at least 50 more from Across the world, attending virtually.

We also expect at least 30 trainees and other health care workers to attend in person and a similar number attending virtually.

This event will be advertised on professional fora like Ozbug (ASID), CSANZ, ANZSCTS and Stroke Society. As well as at the world endocarditis conference, ISCVI, in Malmo Sweden in June.

Any profits generated by this symposium will go into research, including the endocarditis biobank, and a prize for best research project at the ACE research day in October 2025 (we expect the prize will cover airfare and accommodation for the project to be presented at ISCVI 2026).
