Traveller Declaration

As the authorised UQ student traveller, I confirm I have:

- 1. Reviewed the International SOS (ISOS) and DFAT Smartraveller advice (or local government travel advice for students located offshore) and have considered all requirements and restrictions including travel restrictions, public health measures, mandatory quarantine and vaccination requirements (including country-specific expiry timeframes, where relevant).
- 2. Registered my travel with International SOS (ISOS) and have signed up for travel alerts.
- 3. Downloaded the International SOS Assistance App and subscribed to receive SMS messages from Smartraveller for my specific travel destinations.
- 4. Understood that should the Australian Government increase a destination's rating to **'reconsider your need to travel'** once I have departed or am already in-country, UQ will review the risk profile, and this could potentially result in the suspension or cancellation of the experience if UQ considers your safety is at risk. Additionally, any increase in a destination's rating to '**do not travel'** will automatically result in the cancellation of the experience. Whether the costs of travel cancellation or disruption are covered by UQ travel insurance will depend on the particular circumstances and be considered by UQ's travel insurer on a case-by-case basis.
- 5. Understood that all placements undertaken in Low and Middle Income Countries (LMIC) and Least Developed Countries (LDC) will require me to complete a risk assessment in UQ Safe, for approval by the Dean, Medical School, prior to my placement being approved. All reasonable measures will be taken to protect my health and safety including adherence to the risk mitigation measures provided by the placement provider and outlined in my risk assessment.
- 6. A valid passport and visa and other official documentation required for entry and transit through overseas destinations as well as re-entry into Australia (international students will require a valid re-entry visa into Australia).
- 7. Downloaded my International COVID 19 Vaccination Certificate
- Understood UQ expects that all international travellers have their COVID vaccination up-to-date as per the <u>ATAGI definitions</u>. Proof
 of vaccination may be required when travelling internationally. Understood and will meet all pre-travel COVID test and timeframe
 requirements as well as other vaccination requirements
- 9. Read the relevant travel and insurance information on the <u>UQ Insurance Services Website</u>, and understood the conditions, exclusions and limitations of UQ travel insurance detailed on the UQ Insurance Services website.
- 10. Read the <u>UQ Travel Insurance for Students Brochure</u> and completed all required actions including the <u>Fit for Travel Form</u> if I have any pre-existing conditions.
- 11. Understood UQ will not be responsible or liable for managing or funding <u>any</u> issues relating to or arising from private travel.
- 12. Organised my own insurance to cover any days or activities that are not covered by UQ travel insurance (refer to the UQ Travel Insurance for Students brochure).
- 13. Assessed the risks associated with this travel and will take all reasonable precautions to ensure my health, safety, welfare and security.
- 14. Read and will abide by the <u>Student Travel Procedure</u> and other relevant UQ policies and procedures including the <u>UQ Code of</u> <u>Conduct.</u>
- 15. Updated my emergency contact details in <u>mySi-net</u>, InPlace (if applicable) and notified my UQ research supervisor (if applicable) and will update my International SOS (ISOS) MyTrips with my contact details whilst travelling.

- 3. Promptly respond to UQ or ISOS when contacted.
- 4. Comply with any special conditions imposed by a relevant scholarship or funding body.
