

Clinical Rotations at Med Uni Graz

Med Uni Graz has no rotation calendar, your students are welcome throughout the year. It may be difficult to place them at the end of December, beginning of January due to the Christmas holidays. Clinical rotations at Med Uni Graz are hands-on traineeships.

Clinical rotations usually begin on a Monday (ideally the first Monday of the month) and end on a Friday.

All of the departments are open for your students but some departments have restrictions:

- Anesthesiology: German mandatory
- General, Visceral and Transplant Surgery: minimum duration 4 weeks
- Cardiac surgery: minimum duration 4 weeks
- Vascular surgery: German mandatory
- Gynecology: Placements are only possible during holiday periods (February, July to September). Maximum duration 4 weeks.
- Internal medicine: German is generally recommended. It is mandatory in cardiology. Minimum duration 4 weeks.
- Neurology: B2 level German mandatory
- Pediatrics: Placements are possible only as part of educational courses in paediatrics (Educational Course in Paediatric Medicine in February, Multidisciplinary Educational Course in Paediatric Medicine in July). Duration: 4 weeks.
- Psychiatry: B2 level German mandatory
- Emergency medicine: B2 level German mandatory

Students have to be nominated 7 months prior to the intended start of the stay. Please send their names and email addresses to <u>clinicalrotations@medunigraz.at</u> and we will send the application forms directly to the students.

The application documents are:

- Application form
- Data protection policy
- Immunization Requirements form: mandatory immunizations: MMR (2 vaccinations **or** titer), varicella (2 vaccinations **or** titer), Hep B (3 vaccinations **plus** titer)
- CV
- Passport Scan
- Transcript of academic records

The sooner we receive the applications the easier it is to place the students at the requested departments.

Incoming students are enrolled at Med Uni Graz and entitled to accident and liability insurance upon payment of the Austrian student union fee (~ 26 EUR).
